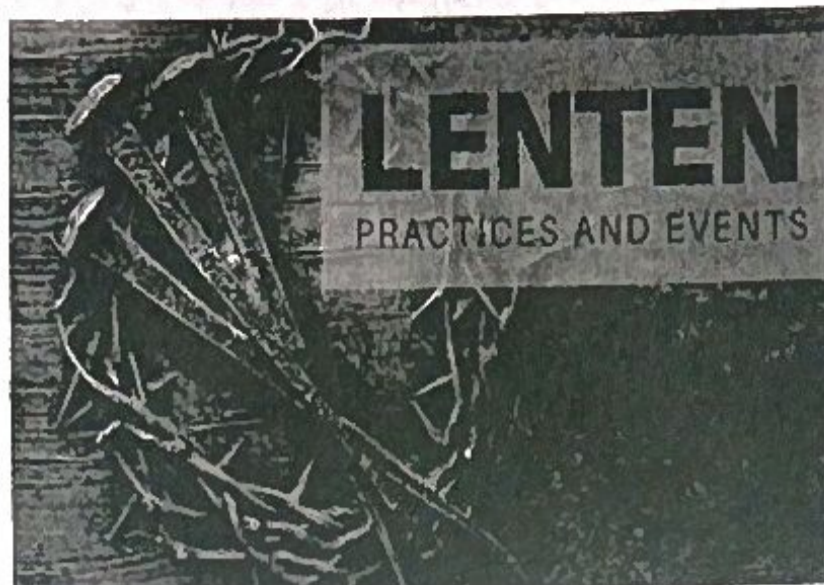

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

This is a reminder that the current discipline of penance for the U.S., in addition to the general character of the Lenten season is summed up as follows: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat and also of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. With regard to Good Friday, the teaching of the 2nd Vatican Council should be recalled: "Let the paschal feast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with uplifted and clear mind" (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, #110). The other Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. Everyone from the 14th birthday is bound to observe the law of abstinence. Everyone from the 18th birthday up to 60th birthday is bound to observe the law of fast.
